Our special guest speaker for this year's SA Prayer Breakfast is **Simon McKeon, 2011 Australian of the Year.**

Simon is Executive Chairman of Macquarie Group's Melbourne office and specialises in mergers and acquisitions. He has degrees in Law and Commerce from the University of Melbourne.

He is Chairman of CSIRO and Business for Millennium Development, a Director of VisionFund, Global Poverty Project and Red Dust Role Models among others. He previously served as President of the Takeovers Panel and Chairman of MS Research Australia.

Simon is the helmsman of Macquarie Innovation which in March 2009 became the first sailboat in the world to sustain more than 50 knots. He is also a Patron of the Australian Olympic Sailing Team which won gold and silver at the Beijing Olympics.

While enjoying a successful corporate career, Simon decided that he didn't want to put off the idea of serious engagement with the community sector until his most productive years were behind him. As a leading social entrepreneur, and committed Christian, Simon demonstrates how business and philanthropy go hand in hand, giving tremendously of his time and energy to many organisations.
