CBMC - A Channel of Blessing (Genesis 12:2)



We CBMC members in Singapore are preparing & working hard for our WORLD CONVENTION. Please see attachment for some details of the convention.

We would like the world to know that we have brothers & sisters in Christ from **so many countries** congregating in Singapore **from 3-6 November 2010** to share our blessings with one another & with others who still do not know our Lord & Saviour Jesus Christ!

Time flies very fast so we would like to encourage as many as possible to sign up before the **early bird price, 1st July 2010** expires.

So far, more than 100 delegates from 14 countries have registered.

We have now decided to add "Budget Hotels" in our website. The information is given here:

Due to several requests especially from Asian countries, we have decided to add **Budget Hotels** to our official list of 3 hotels. Before delegates make their final choice of budget hotels, please note the following:

These budget hotels are essentially "no frills" hotels ie **no breakfast** & no restaurants or cafes for people to have any meals or even have a simple cup of coffee.

Such hotels provide rooms with beds, towels, only basic items. Delegates may even prefer to bring their own bath towels, soap & shampoo.

Budget hotels are generally located in areas with neighbourhoods which are not quite as nice as international hotels.

Locals or Asian delegates might be more familiar with such hotels as they have either been to Singapore or they know what to expect & what not to expect. They also know where they can catch a quick Asian breakfast at local eating places around these hotels at affordable prices. Asians in fact, generally prefer such food to that offered in international hotels for breakfast.

If delegates can rough it out without breakfast, they can request to stay in such hotels when they register for World Convention.

The 2 budget hotels are (1) FRAGRANCE HOTEL & (2) **Le Peranakan Singapore**

The budget hotels & charges are:

Fragrance Hotel – Joo Chiat (located at No 219 Joo Chait Rd)

- 1. Room Type & Rate: 20 x Superior Twin Rooms (c/w 2-single beds) @\$65nett prpn**
- 2. Room Type & Rate: 20 x Superior Double Rooms (c/w 1-queen bed) @ \$65nett prpn**
- 3. Room Type & Rate: 05 x Deluxe Room (c/w 1- king bed) @ \$75nett prpn**
- 4. Room Type & Rate: 05 x Family Room (c/w 1-queen + 1-single bed) @ \$85nett prpn**

Le Peranakan Singapore S\$75/ twin sharing.

Note: All prices are quoted in Singapore dollars. They are **per room per night.**

VERY IMPORTANT NOTE: It is best to book as a group if delegates wish to select budget hotels. Unless there are at least 20 delegates or more in each budget hotel, the World Convention Committee may not be able to provide transport to & from the Convention site ie, **SINGAPORE EXPO CONVENTION CENTRE.** Our original planning budget included transportation from the **3 official hotels only** so with these additional budget hotels, we would incur costs outside our budget. In spite of that, so long as there are 20 delegates, we would still be prepared to bear the costs.

The email which follows below was sent out to Singapore Board members today & I hope it encourages you to know that we are trusting God to supply us with **more than 1,000 delegates from more than 50 countries and He will meet our financial needs.**

Dear All

God is great and wants to encourage all of us after last evening's Board meeting!

Today, a client walked into our office to pay premium for her House Insurance. There was a few dollars change and she said, "Please buy some curry puff for your staff with the change. Here's another S\$50 since it is not enough." I told her S\$50 will be too much & then I would have to return her the change. Then the Lord prompted me to automatically say, "I am serving in a World Convention function where we are helping to support some delegates to come to attend. Is it ok with you that I pass the leftover change to this fund?". She immediately said, "Sure, you can do with it as you like". I thanked her and gave thanks in my heart to the Lord for blessing us with another small donation.

When we look at the "widow's mite", it is not the amount but the willingness to give that counts in the eyes of our Lord.

I just had to share this experience while it is still fresh in my mind.

So now, I shall put in another S\$55/- to our Convention Fund, the left over "curry puff" money. By the way, I did buy curry puffs for my staff so that duty was discharged! The donor met my staff buying the curry puff and my staff thanked her again. So she witnessed the blessing of her giving.

I shared this verse with Lionel this morning (before the lady came into our office) from Malachi 3:10, "Bring ye the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove Me now herewith, saith the LORD of Hosts, if I will not **open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.**"
